"EARN · SAVE · GIVE"

John Wesley, the founder of the Methodist movement, wrote a memorable sermon entitled, "The Use of Money." In fact, Wesley wrote many sermons about money, which shouldn't be surprising seeing that Jesus talked more about money than any topic other than the Kingdom of God. Wesley's simple philosophy or theology about money was "Earn all you can....., Save all you can....., and Give all you can." We are going to take a look at each of these during the next three weeks. All of this is a basis to consider our own "use of money" and how that fits in with my faith and my commitment to the church.

This series is a part of our annual financial commitment campaign. We have entitled it "Earn-Save-Give." You will be receiving a letter and "Estimate of Giving" Commitment card in the mail in the next week or so. If you are not yet a member of the church, but think of Wesley as your church "home," we will have copies of the letter and card in the narthex and by each door. Over the next three weeks, we are asking you to prayerfully consider what God would have you bring in your "tithes and offering" for 2019, to fill out the card, and bring it back to church on October 28 as an offering to God. The Bible called the "tithe" (10%) the basic expression of our stewardship of what God has provided for us. One of the challenges we are asking you to consider is that if you are not yet tithing to take a "step of faith" towards it by increasing your giving by 1% or more.

Everything we have is a gift from God, and we are called to consider what we can give in response to all God has given us. How can we be a responsible steward of the opportunities, talents, and provisions God has provided for us. Every person's gift matters as we partner together to do ministry at Wesley. Our 2018 Annual Budget is \$1,868,620, and we are currently putting together the 2019 budget to be approved in December. As you can see, it takes us all generously responding to God's graciousness in our lives in order to be about the great commission of "making disciples of Jesus Christ."

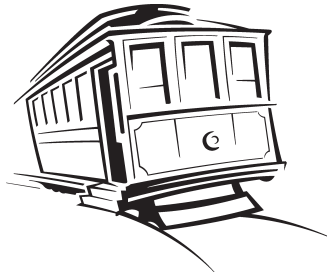
