This morning, a team of our youth will depart for a mission trip to Chattanooga, TN. Youthworks, a national youth mission sending organization, has long-term partnerships in communities all across the country. Each year, hundreds of Youthworks teams spend a week serving churches, non-profits, and other community service organizations at these sites. So as we serve this week in Chattanooga, we will be building on the work of other teams that have come before and contributing to the well-being of the community.
