SUMMER MISSIONS

All last week our youth were in Chattanooga, Tennessee on a mission trip. A special thanks to the adults who led the team. There is something powerful about leaving your normal setting to go away with a group to serve people in need in the name of Jesus. In October we will send a team of adults to Tapachula, Mexico to serve as a staff relief team in the Mission on the Move Children's Home. If you would be interested in the trip, please let us know.

While going away on a mission trip is a meaningful experience, there are equally meaningful opportunities to be in mission locally. Tomorrow we will begin hosting the children from Urban Hope for three days at our church. Urban Hope is a ministry to at-risk inner city children that was started by Wesley member Jack Roszkowiak. Jack went home to be with the Lord in 2015 but the ministry he started continues to touch the lives of dozens of children each year. Many Wesley members have taken up the mantle from Jack and continue to give leadership to Urban Hope. Tomorrow at 2:00 p.m., we will have a "Picnic with a Purpose" where we can join the Urban Hope children for ice cream. School supplies for the upcoming year are needed and a list can be found under Nelle's announcement in today's bulletin.

Next Month, August 11-18, we will be hosting families from Family Promise. These are families who are temporarily and circumstantially homeless and are on the way to getting back to stable housing. We will need many volunteers that week to welcome, provide meals, wash linens, and serve as overnight hosts. We also continue to work on the Tiny House Project for Homeless Veterans and are preparing to be a part of building a home for Habitat for Humanity. Our work with refugees is ongoing as is our monthly Homeless Camp Breakfast (last Saturday of the month). We hope you will look for ways to be in mission locally, nationally, or internationally and share the love of Christ with those who need to know God cares for them.
