Mission Program Profile: Homeless Ministry

Name of Program/Organization

Homeless Ministry – through Chatham Savannah Authority for the Homeless (CSAH): Tiny Houses (homeless veterans) and monthly breakfast for homeless individuals

Target Population

Tiny Houses – homeless veterans (72 houses at The Cove at Dundee)
Monthly Wesley Breakfast – homeless individuals (approx. 25 individuals)

Agency Mission/Purpose

The CSAH mission is to lead the effort to build and sustain community practices to eliminate homelessness through the collective and coordinated efforts of nonprofit service providers, government officials, business leaders and the faith community.

The Tiny House Community provides a tiny home and access to support and referral services, with the goal of enabling veterans to establish stability in their life.

The Monthly Wesley Breakfast is part of a larger volunteer system that provides nutrition to the homeless through Emmaus House (breakfast every Monday); Inner City Night Shelter (dinner M-F); Old Savannah City Mission (lunch M-F); Savannah Baptist Center (lunch every Monday); Social Apostolate (lunch T-F); and Salvation Army (dinner M-F).
