# **Monica Dekle, Director of Music and Organist Leaning on the Everlasting Arms**

Elisha Hoffman and Anthony Showalter wrote today's opening hymn, "Leaning on the Everlasting Arms." Showalter wrote the refrain and the music, and he asked Hoffman to write the stanzas.

Showalter was a musician who taught at singing schools and studied music in England, France, and Germany. He was also an elder of First Presbyterian Church in Dalton, Georgia. Showalter was inspired by scripture to write this hymn when he heard news that the wives of two of his former pupils had died and were buried the same day. He wrote a letter of sympathy to his pupils, and in it he crafted the refrain of the hymn we sing today. He wrote it based on Deuteronomy 33:27, "The eternal God is thy refuge, and underneath are the everlasting arms: and he shall thrust out the enemy from before thee; and shall say, Destroy them."
