**MISSION ON THE MOVE**

Over the last twenty years, I have had the privilege of both serving on the Board and taking some mission teams to Mexico and Honduras to serve with Mission on the Move. At Wesley, we have continued to support this wonderful ministry to children. We are planning to take a mission team to Honduras, February 17-24, 2023, and we hope to plan for a junior and senior trip to Tapachula with youth at some point.

Mission on the Move is a 501-c3 non-profit Christian children's ministry founded in 1986 by retired United Methodist Minister Ed Cadle at the age of 64. "Papa Ed" had a heart for the poverty-stricken people of Central America. And, with no real missionary experience and not being a Spanish speaker, he began the ministry of MOM in Honduras and Mexico. He obeyed the calling of God, began meeting the needs of the people God put in his path, and creatively navigated any challenge he faced. He is credited as being the catalyst for governmental legal change in the state of Chiapas, Mexico, to pass a law prohibiting children from living in prisons with their incarcerated parents.

This morning we are happy to have three of the Mission on the Move Missionaries with us. Ernie and Allison Sizemore have been with us before. After careers working in family businesses and serving as foster parents, Ernie and Allison Sizemore felt called to full time ministry. Ernie and Allison traveled to Honduras with Mission on the Move and felt called to work with the children and families living in rural Santa Elena, Honduras. In 2012, they were commissioned in their home church, First Baptist Church, Augusta, and in April of 2013, Ernie, Allison, and their three children moved to Honduras full time. Since then, the After-School Program has grown to include numerous kids from the local community, 3 Family-Style Children's Homes, and a Community Center that meets the needs of kids in the local community with special abilities. Their biggest joy of being missionaries has been the relationships that have grown into deep friendships. They treasure the opportunity to share their faith in daily life in their community.

We are also happy to welcome Donna Zipperer. Donna began her missionary journey in 1988 with Rev. Ed Cadle, founder of Mission on the Move, doing short term mission trips. In 2000, she made her first trip to Honduras working with medical teams. On that trip she fell in love with the people and the country and knew she wanted to retire from pediatric nursing and serve full time with the children there. After 10 years of serving on the Board of Directors, she answered that call in February of 2017 and has been a full time missionary since. She finds joy in serving the children there and watching them grow in the love of Christ.
