"THIS IS A DAY OF NEW BEGINNINGS"

All through the Bible we find God revealed as a "God of new beginnings." God is always starting over, resurrecting and re-creating his people, shaping us into His image. We have long looked at the beginning of a new year as a time to recommit ourselves to being made "new." We make "New Year's" resolutions about many kinds of self-improvement.

My New Year's resolutions aren't usually to do anything I've never done before, but to recapture what I never should have gotten away from. Therefore, for me, it is important to enter a new year by looking back and being reminded of who I am. As Christians, our identity is grounded in our baptism. Every time we baptize a baby, we are saying that this child belongs to God, that God has a claim on his/her life. Eventually we are challenged to embrace that claim by our own commitment to Christ as our savior and to submit to his Lordship or authority in our lives. This morning on the first Sunday of Epiphany when we remember the baptism of Jesus, we invite our congregation to renew our commitment to Christ by a reaffirmation of our Baptismal covenant with God.

At the end of our service this morning, you will be invited to renew your commitment to Christ and the Church by renewing your vows of baptism. As a symbol of that renewed commitment we will come forward to touch the baptismal waters as you hear the words, "Remember you are a baptized child of God and be thankful." If you would like to stop at the chancel rail for a time of prayer, you are invited to do so. If you have never been baptized and you feel led to make a public profession of your faith in Christ and be baptized, wait until the end of line and then come up and let me know that is your desire and we would be honored to lead you in that commitment and baptize you. Let this be for us all a day to remember and reclaim our primary identity as a follower of Jesus Christ.

James P. Owens, Director of Student Ministries Ski Trip, February 2-5


