The Administrative Board

Tomorrow night our 2023 Administrative Board meets for the first time this year. This is our primary governing body. Our Board is made of 53 church members (30 committee chairs or ministry area representatives and 23 at-large members) plus the staff. It is representative of a wide demographic in our church and every ministry area. While most of the hands-on planning work for our ministries takes place in the 23 different committees that cover every ministry area in our church, the Board gives oversight to our whole ministry and accountability for the staff and committees. Every year 1/3 of the board changes, which keeps new leadership consistently rotating in.

One of the things I appreciate about the United Methodist Church is the way we are governed. Though our system of committees and a large Administrative Board can sometimes make decision making slower, it also bring lots of wisdom, patience, and accountability to our decision making. Camille Russo will be our Board Chair for her second year. The chair serves for two years and then the vice-chair takes over for two years. Our vice-chair is Johnny Phelps.

One of the topics that our Board has discussed over the past year is where we stand on possible disaffiliation from the United Methodist Church. Our Board has discussed this topic and unanimously agreed that to entertain a vote to leave the denomination would only be damaging to the wonderful things that are happing in our church. Asking a thriving church like ours to pick sides and create winners and losers is counterproductive to our witness to the gospel and the love of God in Christ that welcomes all and unites people with different views and opinions in a common ministry.

Board meetings are open to all and attending is a great way to become more informed about our ministry. The meetings take place in our Fellowship Hall at 5:30 p.m. on the last Monday of every other month. The dates for 2023 are: January 30, March 27, May 22, August 28, October 30, and December 11.
