WELCOME MONACO BOYS CHOIR

Please welcome to the 11:00 Service Pierre Debat and the Monaco Boys Choir, under the High Patronage of H.S.H Prince Albert II of Monaco. The choir's origins date back to the reign of Prince Antoine ler (1661-1731), but it was not until 1974 that the Boys' Choir was formed at Monaco Cathedral. Regularly taking part in religious services, the choir of around thirty boys aged between 9 and 16 also performs at concerts held on special occasions in Monaco. Recently, the Boys' Choir took part in Commemorations marking the Centenary of the birth of Prince Rainier III on May 31, 2023, paying a wonderful tribute to the Builder Prince, who founded the choir.

Massie Heritage Center Door Painting Contest

The old front doors of the Massie Heritage Center lead to one of the most imaginative places to explore and learn in the Historic District of Savannah. The present appearance of these doors is not inviting, so the Friends of Massie (FOM) decided it was time to make a colorful change.

Teaming up with the color experts at Benjamin Moore Paint, four historic colors were selected. The building belongs to the Savannah Chatham County Public Schools, but the FOM reasoned that the neighbors and visitors should participate in the choice of new color for these doors.

From July 12 – July 23, locals can vote for their favorite front door color at the Massie Heritage Center, 207 East Gordon Street, open from 10:00 a.m.-4:00 p.m. seven days a week. Color samples from which to make the selection and voting ballots will be available by the front door.

The color with the most votes will be selected as the new paint color, and work will begin on July 23. The winning color that the neighborhood selected will be announced on Friday July 30 with the freshly painted doors revealed.
