SUNDAY AFTERNOON SPIRITUAL PRACTICES AT WESLEY GARDENS RETREAT

Last Sunday, in my sermon about the man who said to Jesus, "I believe, help my unbelief," I suggested that maybe we should be praying for more faith. Maybe instead of always praying for the outcome, we should be praying for the input. The man had faith, but he was asking Jesus to give him a reason to have more faith. To pray such a prayer is risky. What would happen to me if God gave me a personal experience that increased my faith? How might it affect my life? I suggested that maybe in 2024, we should pray that prayer every day, "I believe, help my unbelief." But praying the prayer may not be so effective if I don't find ways to be with God in an intentional way to receive such an experience. So, I also suggested that in addition to praying the prayer, we should find ways to spend some time paying attention to God.

We want to offer you an opportunity for that kind of focused attention. Beginning this afternoon, at 4:00 p.m. on Sunday afternoons at Wesley Gardens Retreat, Christian Swails, our Director of Spiritual Formation, will offer a time of guided Spiritual practices. A large part of Spiritual Formation is creating space in our busy, crowded lives to encounter God. Christian is inviting us in the tradition of Jesus and his disciples to "come away to quiet place". There, he will "hold some space" with us where we can pay attention to what God might want to show us that will help us grow the faith of Jesus, faith grounded in personal experience, an encounter with the Word, the creation, and the fellowship of fellow faith seekers.

We hope you will consider risking this kind of a spiritual journey. We may be surprised at how God answers our prayer for more faith.
