THE CAPSTONE PROJECT UPDATE

Last May, we held a Church Conference and voted to move forward with renovating the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th Floors of our Education Building. The building is now 100 years old and hasn't had a major renovation in decades. This space is devoted to Children's Programs and Music, two of the fastest growing and most valued hallmarks of our church. The plan addresses much-needed deferred maintenance needs, including life safety issues such as a firewall and updated sprinkler system, enhanced security on the children's hallways, and correction of water damage. In addition, we wish to upgrade and expand bathrooms, create a new music suite to accommodate the growth of our program, improve the Sunday School, Children's Worship, and Eli's Place educational space, and generally bring these three floors up to the standards in appearance and functionality befitting the remainder of our beautiful campus. This renovation is the Capstone Phase of our 15-year Master Plan and is expected to satisfy our infrastructure needs for many years to come.

We entertained bids on the project and selected The Pinyan Company as our contractor to work with our architects, Lott and Naugle. The cost of the project has come in at 3.5 million dollars. What we were not expecting is that our elevator would suffer a lightning strike, which has left it unreliable with its outdated operating system. We are now adding a complete renovation of the elevator to the project. The cost is approximately \$250,000. This means we need your help in funding this extensive and necessary project.

We began fundraising with \$929,729 from previous gifts and overages from previous years. Our Capital fundraising has produced 174 pledges totaling \$1,664,560. We are so thankful for your generous commitments. Our Finance Committee has a very good plan to be able to move ahead and fund the project, but we need everyone's help. If you have not yet made a commitment to the project, we ask that you prayerfully consider doing so. Every gift matters in this important project.

Next Sunday, after the 11:00 service, we will have a "Groundbreaking" for the project, which will include lunch, information about how we will work in the interim while we are giving up so much of our space during the renovation, and a time of financial commitment from those who may not have yet committed and those who might could do a little more. Work is expected to begin on March 6, and this will be our last big event in the Fellowship Hall before we divide it into multiple rooms to house Eli's Place and Sunday School Classes.
