St. Patrick's Day & Lent

Obviously, St. Patrick's Day is a pretty big day in Savannah. Thousands of people visit our city to celebrate—many thanks to all who supported our youth breakfast yesterday by working, donating, or eating. I'm not real sure, unless you are Irish and even more specifically Irish Catholic, if all the celebration is really about St. Patrick or the arrival of spring or just a good reason to celebrate. I'm not sure if it's day for saints or sinners or both. I have been on both sides of the fence on St. Patrick's Day. After all, the Apostle Paul called us all saints, but he also called us all sinners. The reality is we who follow Jesus are both saints and sinners. We are called for our lives to be set apart for Him, but we are bound by our own desire and shaped by the culture in which we live. Those who know St. Patrick's story know his mission was to invite sinners to become saints.

With the arrival of St. Patrick's Day, Lent is winding down. One week from today, we will remember the arrival of Jesus in Jerusalem on Palm Sunday, and then we will enter Holy Week and count down the last days of His life and mourn our sin which led to His death. Spring has arrived a bit early, and the earthly signs of resurrection have already made us forget the darkness that fell on "Good Friday" and the coldness of his tomb on Holy Saturday. As we follow him along in the last days of this Lenten journey, we hear his call to "die every day" to self and sin so that we might be raised to a new life of service and holiness.

Remember that during Holy Week, we will have services each day at lunch and an evening Maundy Thursday communion service and meal instead of our normal Wednesday night dinner. We hope you will make plans to join us.
