CONFIRMATION

In the Wesleyan/Methodist tradition, we emphasize the process of salvation as a lifelong journey of growing in grace. We believe that journey begins before we ever know it. In infant baptism, we recognize the "prevenient grace" of God. We acknowledge a child belongs to God, and God claims and loves that child for who they are, not what they have or haven't done. Parents and the church take the responsibility to teach and lead that child into an understanding of who they are as a beloved child of God. At some point, the child grows old enough to claim that identity for themself and embrace faith in Christ as their own. We call that an experience of "justifying grace." It is represented in the event of Confirmation. Then begins a journey through the rest of their lives of growing in the grace of God and the likeness of Christ. We call that "sanctifying grace."

Over the last nine months, fifteen of our students have been meeting with me in a Confirmation Class. We have been learning about the fundamentals of Christian faith and what it means to be a follower of Christ and a member of Wesley Monumental UMC. This morning, they commit themselves to continuing their journey of salvation and their experience of grace. We are grateful for the families and church members who have sown faith, hope, and love into their lives and brought them to this special day.

Christian Swails, Wesley Gardens Spiritual Director


