BACK TO "NORMAL"

The Advent-Christmas-Epiphany (New Year) schedule at Wesley is full of special worship and fellowship events. During that time, we step out of our "normal" schedule of worship, study, fellowship, and service. This week, we finally return to "normal," both in our personal schedules (school is back in, and vacations are mostly over) and in our church schedule.

This afternoon, our Spiritual Practices at Wesley Gardens Retreat Center, led by Christian Swails, will resume with a revised pattern of practices. Each week of the month will feature a particular spiritual practice, including the new Book Club, which will be the last Sunday of the month. The first classic book is "The Practice of the Presence of God" by Brother Lawrence (written in 1692).

This Wednesday evening, we will resume our Wednesday Night at Wesley program. It features a weekly dinner, our children's choirs, youth group, adult studies (there are four to choose from; see the insert), and chancel choir rehearsal. We hope you will make Wednesday night a brief spiritual respite in the middle of busy weeks to keep us grounded in our faith.

All our mid-week Bible Studies will meet this week (Tuesday morning Men's Bible Study Breakfast at Sunnyside Up restaurant on Derene Ave, Tuesday morning Young Mothers' study at Wesley, Wednesday morning Bible Study with Ben at Wesley, and Thursday Noon Bible Study with Nelle online).

Our commitment to a "routine" or "habit" of spiritual practices is a meaningful path to a deeper relationship with Christ and growing consistently into who God has made us to be.

And remember, worship happens every week. I am beginning a new series of sermons entitled "One." based on Ephesians 4:1-6. I look forward to seeing you at Wesley in 2025!
