PENTECOST & MEET US AT THE GARDENS

Today, the Church celebrates the Day of Pentecost. The first two chapters of the book of Acts tell the story of the day the Holy Spirit fell upon the first followers of Jesus. On that day, they were described as being "all together in one place" when the Spirit empowered and inspired them to bear a compelling witness to people of all races, languages, nations, and religions. The witness they bore was in the courageous and persuasive way they loved in the face of opposition, in the unity they found that cut across boundaries, in the generosity they showed to all who had need, and in the compassion and healing they offered to all who were sick and suffering. For a brief time in history, that fledgling Church bore a witness to the Kingdom of God. Ever since then, the Church has tried to live up to that example. As the first followers found, the sins of selfishness and superiority are everpresent, and the need for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit in the Church and world is constant. May it be so among us here at Wesley and in this community where we bear witness to the love of God in Christ.
