WELCOME REV. DR. SCOTT HAGAN

This morning, we are glad to welcome our District Superintendent, the Rev. Dr. Scott Hagan, to Wesley Monumental. This has been planned for quite a while, but in light of our recent sanctuary situation, it seems a good time to be reminded of our connection as United Methodist. Many of you know our church was originally built with donations of Methodist people from around the world as a "monument" to the Wesley Movement and its founders, John and Charles Wesley. It is good to be reminded that we are never alone in our work of ministry. Trinity UMC, our "mother church," has offered its sanctuary for any weddings or special events while we repair our sanctuary. We are also reminded of that today through the gracious hospitality of our longtime neighbors, the Congregation Mickve Israel.

The Reverend Doctor Scott Hagan has served as the Superintendent for the Coastal District of the UMC since 2023. He was born in Brunswick, Georgia, to Dan and Miriam Hagan. He grew up in Statesboro with his younger brother Kirk. After a stint in men's basketball working for Georgia Tech, the Atlanta Hawks, and USA Basketball, Scott answered the call to ministry in 1999.

He is married to Julie, a public school librarian, and they have two sons: Sam, a graduate of Georgia Southern University, currently living in Middle Georgia and working with Alfa Insurance; and Jack, a junior at Georgia Southern, studying finance and working at the college golf course—mainly so he can play six days a week for free. Both boys take great pride in beating their dad at just about every competition they can find.

Mission Committee Accepting Applications

The Mission Committee is accepting applications from non-profit organizations for funding in 2026. Deadline is September 1, 2025. Organizations must complete a two-page application for consideration. The simple application helps to determine how the organization: 1) serves community needs; 2) fosters faith-based activity; and 3) empowers volunteer opportunities for members at Wesley Monumental. In 2025, the Mission Committee approved 46.3% of its funding from the Administrative Board for organizations that serve women and children in need; 32.3% to feed and house the least among us; and 14.3% for international missions. Organizations that received funding in 2025 are Ceceline Blake Foundation, Frank Callen Boys & Girls Club, Fresh Air Home, Inspiritus, Living Vine, Mission on the Move, PACK, Second Harvest Food Bank, Tybee Stops Traffic(king), UMCOR, Urban Hope, and the Wesley Community Center.
