This morning is "Promotion Sunday." It is the day each year when our children and youth are "promoted" to their next age-appropriate Sunday School class. It is also a day we use to "promote" Sunday School for our adults. Sunday School has an important place in the process of Spiritual formation or growth for all ages. In these smaller group settings, we study together and learn more about our faith, but we also build relationships and support each other on our spiritual journey. Sunday School begins with our youngest children and goes through our most mature adults because we believe salvation (being shaped in the image of Jesus) is a lifelong process of transformation and growth.

Mission Committee Accepting Applications

The Mission Committee is accepting applications from non-profit organizations for funding in 2026. Deadline is September 1, 2025. Organizations must complete a two-page application for consideration. The simple application helps to determine how the organization: 1) serves community needs; 2) fosters faith-based activity; and 3) empowers volunteer opportunities for members at Wesley Monumental. In 2025, the Mission Committee approved 46.3% of its funding from the Administrative Board for organizations that serve women and children in need; 32.3% to feed and house the least among us; and 14.3% for international missions. Organizations that received funding in 2025 are Ceceline Blake Foundation, Frank Callen Boys & Girls Club, Fresh Air Home, Inspiritus, Living Vine, Mission on the Move, PACK, Second Harvest Food Bank, Tybee Stops Traffic(king), UMCOR, Urban Hope, and the Wesley Community Center.
