#### **WEDNESDAY NIGHTS AT WESLEY**

After a long summer break, we return this week to our mid-week programming, Wednesday Nights at Wesley. This is an event for the whole family, and we hope a gift to you in the middle of busy weeks. Each week, you will be provided with a wonderful meal and some encouraging programming for children, youth, and adults. Before dinner begins, at 4:45 p.m., we gather to pray, and this year, for monthly communion. Dinner is at 5:30 p.m. (We hope you will make a standing reservation; you can pay for the whole semester at once and receive a free week). After dinner, there is Joyful Noise and Children's Choir programming (a nursery is available for younger children). The Youth Group offers Bible study, and the adults are offered three programs from which to choose. (1) A Women's Small Group. (2) Glen Doki teaches "Pilgrim's Progress" (a classic spiritual book by John Bunyan). (3) Ben Martin teaches "Being a United Methodist Christian" (6 weeks), followed by a Bible Study on Jonah, and an Advent study led by Carolyn Hale Cubbedge. We hope you will make this a regular part of your week.

#### **SAVE OUR SANCTUARY**

This week, you should have received a letter and pledge card asking you to help us with the repair and restoration of our sanctuary. We have had a remarkable early response, but we all need to reach our financial goal to pay for this large, unexpected expense. While we do not yet know the full cost of this project, as there are many potential unforeseen issues requiring repair, we are making a somewhat informed guess at \$1.5 million for the cost, but are setting the capital campaign goal at \$2 million, with any overage going to replenish our Endowment (it provides income for ongoing capital expense). If you didn't receive a letter and pledge form, they are available at the entrance this morning. You have been extraordinarily generous in the recent renovation of the Education Building, and this was something we didn't anticipate. Will you prayerfully consider how God is calling you to be part of returning us to our sanctuary.
