BIBLE PRESENTATION SUNDAY

"All scripture is inspired by God and is useful for teaching, for reproof, for correction, and for training in righteousness, so everyone who belongs to God may be proficient, equipped for every good work."

The Bible is the book around which our faith is built and our worship centers. That being said, it is not the book we worship, but the one who reveals himself through the book. We talk about the Bible as a living word. It continues to speak in a fresh way to people of faith, even though it was written thousands of years ago in a very different culture. And it continues to speak in new and fresh ways to each of us throughout our lives. As our stage of life and circumstances change, we see and hear things in the book we didn't notice before. While there are many ways God "speaks" and the spiritual life is one of learning the spiritual practice of discernment, the Bible is the primary medium through which God has spoken to believers throughout history.

Because we are a "people of the Book," our children grow up here learning the stories, characters, and principles or virtues extolled in the Bible. Most importantly, they learn who Jesus is and what he means to each of us. Every year, we present our 2nd graders with their own Bible. It is our prayer that they will learn how to "hide the word in their heart" with the help of parents and teachers at Wesley. Most of all, we hope they will learn how to listen through the book to hear God speak to them about how much they are loved and what is the true meaning and purpose of their lives.
